

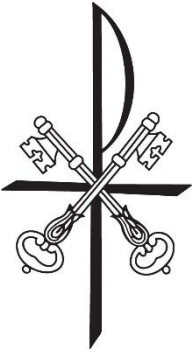

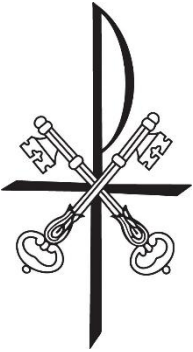
Bless our parents, who are the first teachers of their children. Grant them wisdom, courage, and peace as they nurture their families in faith and love.

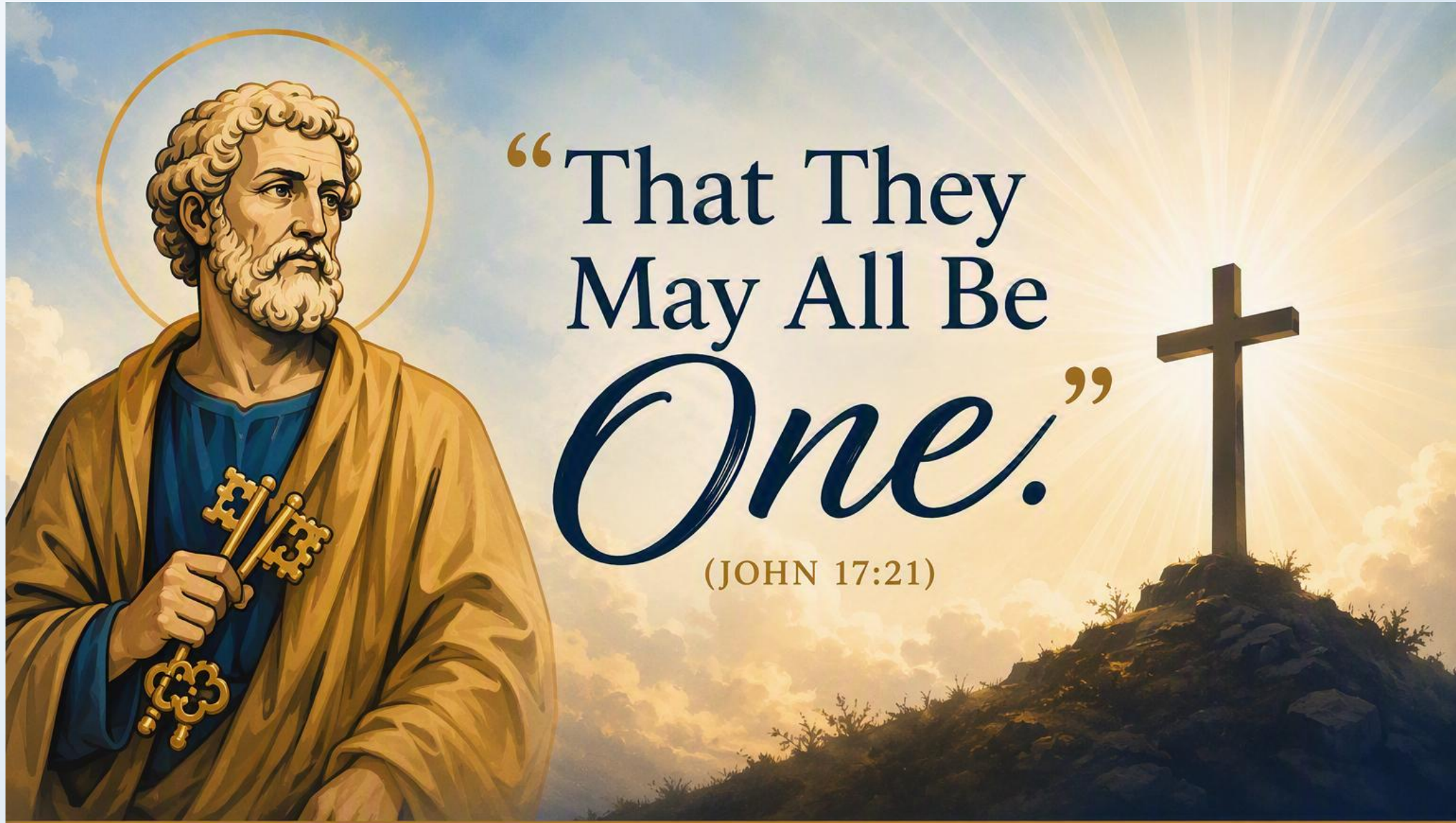

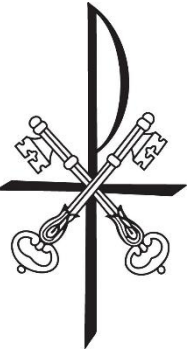
May our school be a place where all are welcomed, respected, and valued; a community united in faith and committed to helping one another become the people You created us to be.
