# Spiritual Growth

Our three priests lead daily Mass and monthly Penance for our students.

School Sisters of Christ the King teach in our school and prepare students for First Penance, First Communion, and Confirmation. The 4th through 8th grade boys are encouraged to participate in our altar serving program.

Classes participate in Catechesis of the Good Shepherd in our Atrium, a place of quiet and meditative discovery where children listen to the good Shepherd's voice during catechetical presentations and can meditate on God's Word while working.

We have annual traditions that include a Saint Parade, Living Rosary, Stations of the Cross, Eucharistic Procession and May Crowning.



Students participate in the *Education in Virtue* series, a curriculum from the Dominican Sisters of Mary designed to help students “learn, live, and witness the virtues and gifts of the Holy Spirit.”
