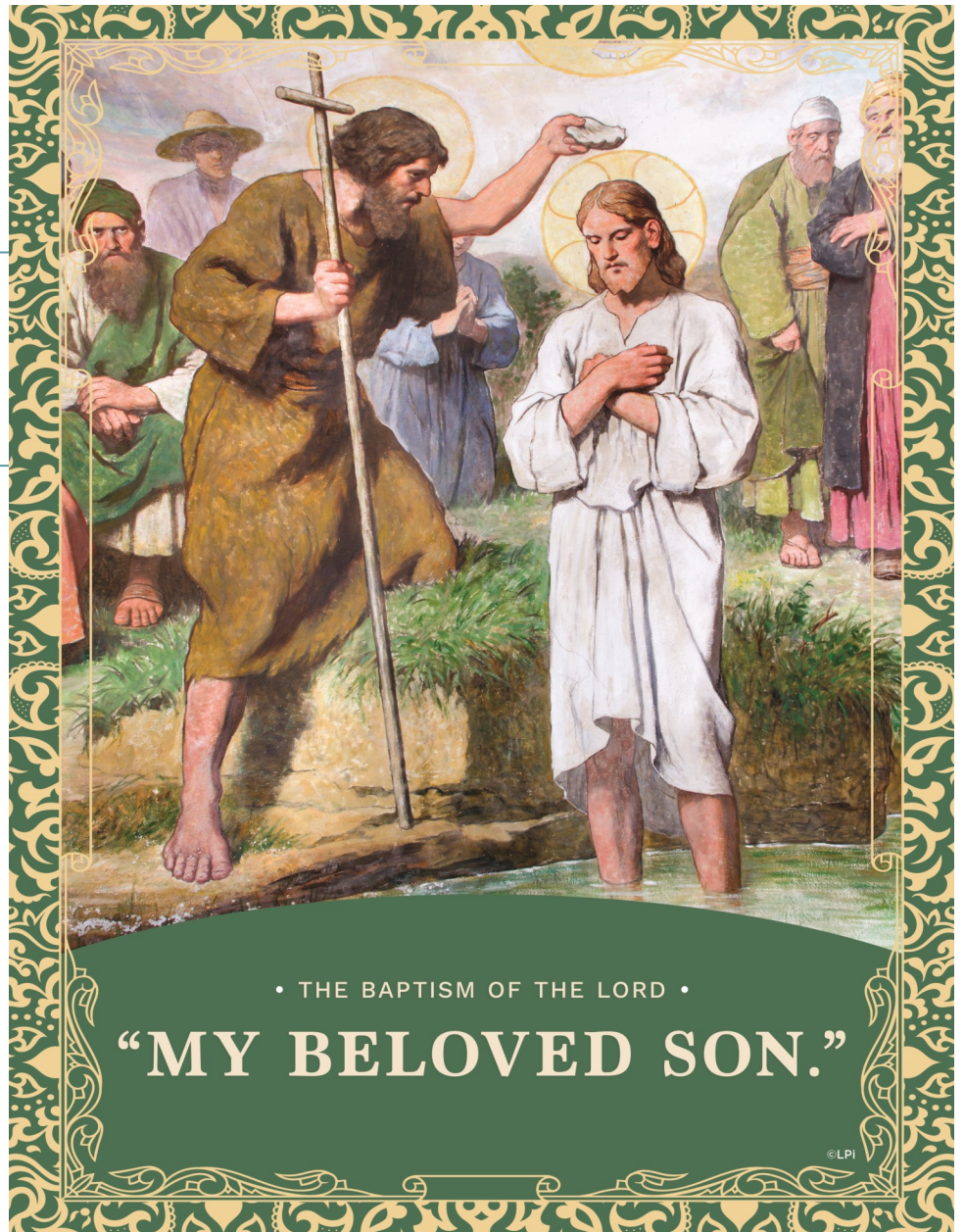

Sanctuary & Church Event Policy

The church is a sacred space which has been consecrated as a place set apart for prayer. We at St. Peter Church are striving to abide in Christ by designating a place for perpetual Eucharist Adoration. We ask all to please respect the dignity of the place by respecting silence by turning phones off, no food, drink, gum or pets (unless service dog). Thank you for your understanding.

“The church, the house of God, is the proper place for the liturgical prayer of the parish community. It is also the privileged place for adoration of the real presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament” (CCC 2691).

What is allowed in the Church:

- Sacraments
- Benediction
- Private prayer and adoration
- Church cleaning and decorating
- Communal devotions (rosary, stations of the cross, litanies, Liturgy of Hours, ect.)
- Praise and worship
- Rehearsals for sacraments (weddings, confirmation, 1st Communion & penance, ect.)
- Homilies during retreats by deacon or priest
- Training for ministers of the liturgy (servers, readers, acolytes, ect.)
- Church tours for educational purposes (OCIA, CCD, school, ect.)

What is not allowed in the Church:

- Plays and productions
- Talks and promotional events
- Graduations
- Concerts
- Music recitals
- Group meetings, bible studies, prayer groups
- Sacramentals and devotions that distract from Eucharist Adoration

We can provide other locations in our building for other activities that are not allowed in the sanctuary. If you have any questions, please contact the pastor.
